EXPLANATORY NOTES

A standard unit of 10 credit points involves three hours of class contact per week, consisting of 2 hours of whole-class lectures and a 1-hour tutorial. Where there is a variation in this structure, or where further information regarding a unit is available, a number will appear in brackets after the timetable entry for the unit concerned, which correlates to an Explanatory Note below. Students are to ensure that they read and understand the Notes which correspond to the units in which they are enrolled or intend to enrol for Semester 2, 2008.

Timetable entries include a unit code, tutorial group (if applicable), lecturer's initials, student group, year level and room. Tutorial groups are indicated by 'U' to 'Z', depending upon the number needed [eg: EL104W CA e1m1 E1 – the unit is SC104, tutorial group W; CA is the lecturer; first year Early Years and Middle Years Studies students are the group; in room E1].

- (1) AT104 has two components, *Art* and *Music*, each with weekly contact time of 2 hours, making a total of 4 hours of contact per week for the unit.
- (2) ED114 consists of a combined lecture hour and three separate workshop hours – *Technology, Literacy/Numeracy - Practical*, and *Literacy/Numeracy - Skills* (4 hours per week total for the unit). Students are to stay in the same groups (W/X/Y) for each of the three workshops.
- (3) EL395 will meet fortnightly. See the lecturer for further details of the program for this unit.
- (4) CS120 consists of two lecture groups (A = b1ss1; B = e1m1s1) and six tutorial groups (U/V = b1ss1; W/X/Y/Z = e1m1s1). Students are to attend the groups to which their particular cohorts have been allocated: however, quotas apply to all classes and so students may be allocated to groups other than those indicated.
- (5) CS300 is offered in three modes – internal, external and intensive. All internal Business, Social Science and Graduate Entry Education students are to enrol in the internal mode, while distance education Social Science students may enrol in the Internal or the External mode. Year 4 Education students ONLY are to enrol in the Intensive mode. These arrangements may be varied only with the permission of the School of Christian Studies Program Coordinator. Please note that, in Semester 2, 2008 only, the unit *CS354 Transformation Theology* may be taken in place of CS300 to fulfil course completion requirements.
- (6) Students in preservice teacher education courses attend a program of year-level meetings during the semester. These meetings include practicum and professional experiences briefings, and other activities. Students should consult their Course Coordinator for further details regarding the schedule of meetings for the semester. The Year 4 Meeting will run during Term 4 only.
- (7) BS140 will run from 4.30-7.30 on Mondays.
- (8) On Tuesdays, HP104 will be structured to have Tutorial Group X from 9.00-10.50 (2 hours), the whole-class lecture from 11.10-12.00 (1 hour), and Tutorial Group Y from 12.10-2.00 (2 hours). In Week 1, all students are to meet in E1 at 9.00am.
- (9) Year 4 Education Students have no classes in Term 3 due to their School-based Internship program. In Term 4, these students take 2 units (CS300 and ED433) in intensive mode as indicated on the timetable. Students should consult their Course Coordinator for further details.
- (10) HB121/HB421 will run from 4.30-7.30 on Tuesdays.
- (11) SY201 will have 2 hours of lectures per week for each week of Semester 2. For 5 weeks of the semester, the third hour of classes in the week will be taken by the unit lecturer while, for the other 6 weeks of the semester, students will form groups to undertake workshops based upon their particular teaching areas and the hour will be taken by specialist tutors in those teaching areas. These workshops are yet to be scheduled. For more details regarding the arrangements applying to SY201, please see the unit lecturer or your Course Coordinator.
- (12) Students are to remain in the same groups (X/Y/Z) for the CS120 tutorials and the ED114 workshops.
- (13) For the ED318 tutorials, Groups U and V (Wednesday) are for Year 3 SEH students, while Groups X, Y and Z (Friday) are for Year 2 SEH students.
- (14) Students are to remain in the same groups (X/Y/Z) for the ED113 and EL104 tutorials. Students in the Primary/Early Years and Primary/Middle Years courses are to form Groups X and Y, while students in the Secondary/Middle Years courses are to form Group Z.
- (15) HB261/461 will run from 2.00-6.00pm on Thursday afternoons and will consist of whole class and group-based activities.
- (16) Students are to remain in the same groups X, Y and Z for the ED216, ED318 and MA204 tutorials (Fridays only).
