School of Education and Humanities Exit Result Statement

The correlation between standards statements given for individual assessment items and exit results for students in the School of Education and Humanities (SEH) is as follows:

Standard	Assessment Results	Exit Results
Standard 1	Outstanding+ Outstanding Outstanding-	High Distinction
Standard 2	High Quality+ High Quality High Quality-	Distinction
Standard 3	Commendable+ Commendable Commendable-	Credit
Standard 4	Satisfactory+ Satisfactory Satisfactory-	Pass
Standard 5	Unsatisfactory+ Unsatisfactory Unsatisfactory-	Fail

Generally, in order to receive a passing grade, a student must fulfill the requirements for the successful completion of tasks as listed in the relevant assessment guide.

Then, in order to receive a particular Exit Result, a student must achieve at the selected standard for the majority (generally 50%) of the weighted assessment with some of that at a higher level (at least 20%), or achieve at the standard for a vast majority (generally 70%) of the weighted assessment tasks. In both cases, the majority of the rest of the weighted assessment should fall only one standard below.

It should be noted that all exit grades are moderated by the SEH Examiners' Meeting at the conclusion of each semester. This meeting has the authority to moderate students' results to ensure the maintenance of fair and equitable practices both across and within all units.
