The information provided below is correct at the time of printing. All timetable arrangements, including times and room allocations, are subject to change.

Updated versions of the timetable will be posted to the CHC website when they become available. Please check the website regularly. If a timetable change requires you to change the units in which you are enrolled, please submit an *Application for Change to Unit Selection* form as soon as possible.

A standard unit of 10 credit points involves 3 hours of class contact per week, normally consisting of 2 hours of whole-class lectures and a 1-hour tutorial. Where there is a variation in this structure or there is further information about a unit, a number will appear in brackets after the particular timetable entry. This number correlates to an *Explanatory Note* on the opposite page. You must ensure that you read and understand the Explanatory Notes for the units in which you are enrolled or intend to enrol.

Each Timetable entry includes a unit code, tutorial group (if applicable), the lecturer's initials, course group and year level (see 'CODES' below) and room. Tutorial groups are indicated by 'U' through 'Z', depending upon the number needed.

Example: SC104X CA e1m1 A1 – the unit is SC104, tutorial group X; CA is the lecturer; first year Early Years Studies and Middle Years Studies students are the course groups; in room A1.

Explanatory Notes



Where there is a variation to the normal structure of a unit or there is further information available about a unit, a number will appear in brackets after the particular timetable entry. This number corresponds to an *Explanatory Note* below. You must ensure that you read and understand the Explanatory Notes for the units in which you are enrolled or intend to enrol.

- (1) AT104 consists of an Art module and a Music module. Each module has class contact of 2 hours per week, giving a total of 4 hours of contact a week for the unit.
- (2) CS125 is being run as two separate groups – A (Monday) and C (Thursday) [Note: Group B has been cancelled]. Students are to choose ONE of these groups for their attendance and are to remain in the same group for the entire semester (please note that timetable restrictions may apply). Lecture Group A has Tutorial Groups A1 and A2, and Lecture Group C has Tutorial Groups C1 and C2.

In order that all groups are of a similar size and, where possible, contain a mix of students across schools, quotas will apply to each group. Students will be able to nominate their group (subject to timetable restrictions) on a 'first come, first served' basis on the lists located outside the office of Anne Fry (Program Coordinator, School of Christian Studies). The lists will open at the beginning of the week prior to the commencement of Semester 2, 2010 (19 July 2010).
- (3) ED412 will have four hours of class contact per week (Monday 11.00-1.00; Wednesday 9.00-11.00) and will run during Term 3 only.
- (4) Students in preservice teacher education courses attend a program of meetings during the semester which include professional experiences briefings and other activities. Students should consult their Course Coordinator for further details regarding the program of meetings for the semester.
- (6) Note removed.
- (5) CS300 will have four hours of class contact per week (Monday 2.00-4.00; Tuesday 9.00-11.00) and will run during Term 3 only.
- (7) DM230 (Monday 5.00-8.00) and DM120 (Wednesday 5.00-8.00) will use Room R6 on the campus of Citipointe Christian College. See your Course Coordinator for details regarding location.
- (8) HB162 and HB460 will run as a combined 2-hour lecture from 9.00am-11.00am on Tuesdays, followed by two 1-hour tutorial sessions. Students are to attend the lectures and both tutorial sessions, giving a total of 4 hours of class contact per week.
- (9) In Term 3, the lectures for EL104 will be held on Tuesday 11.00-1.00 and the lecture and Extra hour for ED114 will be held on Wednesday 9.00-11.00. In Term 4, these will swap, with the lectures for EL104 moving to Wednesday 9.00-11.00 and the lecture and Extra hour for ED114 moving to Tuesday 11.00-1.00.
- (10) HB388/HB588 will run on Tuesdays from 2.00-4.30pm in Room E2). HB121/HB421 will run on Tuesdays from 4.30-7.00pm in Room E2.
- (11) Students in the School of Social Sciences who need to complete *Module B Personal and Social Relationships* are to join with HB111 during Weeks 7-8 and 10-14.
- (12) TN104 (Wednesday 4.00-7.00) will use Room F10 on the campus of Citipointe Christian College. See your Course Coordinator for details regarding location.
- (13) HB261/HB461 will run from 2.00-5.00pm on Thursday afternoons and will use all of D Block. Students will have access to the rooms for one hour prior to the class (1.00-2.00) and one hour following the class (5.00-6.00). For postgraduate students, HB461 has a prerequisite module (Module C) which students must complete prior to beginning the unit. This module is being held as an intensive session prior to the commencement of Semester 2. Details for this intensive session appear on the *Semester 2, 2010 Intensives Schedule*. Please contact the School of Social Sciences for further details.
- (14) The tutorial groups for EL104 and SC104 on Thursdays (W, X and Y) are to correlate for Primary/Early Years and Primary/Middle Years students. Students are to remain in the same groups for each tutorial session.
- (15) EY404 and MY404 will have a combined lecture on Thursdays from 3.00-4.00, followed by separate tutorials from 4.00-6.00, and will run during Term 3 only.
- (16) SY201 will have associated with it a series of subject area-specific workshops. These workshops will be taken by specialists in each area and will run for a total of 3 hours per subject area across the semester. The schedule for these workshops is to be advised. Further information is available from the unit lecturer.
- (17) CS100 lectures will run on Mondays from 10.30-11.20am and 11.30am-12.20pm, followed by the tutorial from 1.00-1.50pm.
