How to use this document

The information that appears on the following pages lists the units that are offered in Semester 2, 2017. The units are presented in the following groups:

The *mode*, *credit points* and *level* are indicated for each unit, as well as the *funding cluster* to which each unit belongs. Please note that funding clusters are relevant only to students who are enrolled in initial teacher education courses in Commonwealth supported places.

To calculate the tuition fees or student contribution amount for a particular unit, please refer to the *Fees & Charges* information sheet on the CHC website, according to the following guidelines:

- If you are a *domestic* student in a **full fee place**, locate the relevant table of tuition fees (page 1) to determine the fees for the unit according to its level (undergraduate 100-level to 400-level; postgraduate 400-level to 600-level) and credit point weighting. Please note that there are separate tables that apply to fees for *non-Ministries* courses and fees for *Ministries* courses. The fees for Ministries courses apply only to students who are enrolled in Ministries courses. Students who undertake Ministries units within other courses pay fees as relevant to those courses.
- If you are an *overseas* student in a **full fee place**, locate the relevant table of tuition fees (page 2) to determine the fees for the unit according to its level (undergraduate 100-level to 400-level; postgraduate 400-level to 600-level) and credit point weighting.
- If you are a *domestic* student in a **Commonwealth supported place**, locate the table of student contribution amounts (page 3) to determine the amount for the unit according to its funding cluster and EFTSL value (0.1 for the Graduate Diploma in Education (Secondary); 0.125 for all other initial teacher education courses).

The means by which tuition fees and student contribution amounts can be paid are indicated in the relevant sections of the *Fees & Charges* information sheet.
