

END-OF-SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS SEMESTER 3, 2018



The End-of-Semester Examinations week is an official part of the semester and is declared on the CHC [Calendar](#). Students are expected to be available for examinations during this time.

All examinations are 3 hours in duration and are time-limited (see below for an explanation of a 'time-limited' exam).

Students must produce their CHC Student ID Cards to enter examination rooms and display them as instructed. Students who do not produce their CHC Student ID Cards *will not* be permitted entry to examination rooms.

Students are to be ready to enter examination rooms *15 minutes* prior to the advertised commencement of examination sessions.

FURTHER INFORMATION

The CHC [Examinations](#) and [Assessment](#) policies contain explanations of terms and the conditions under which examinations and assessment items are conducted.

Students who are enrolled in units in the external mode undertake *on campus* or *external* sittings of examinations according to their location. The conditions that determine this are explained in the CHC [Invigilation of External Examinations](#) policy.

Students who wish to apply for special consideration with regard to end-of-semester examinations and presentations are to consult the CHC [Examinations](#) policy for the process by which applications are made. Applications for special consideration must be submitted no later than the beginning of **Week 11** of the semester.

Examinations that are **time-limited** are those in which extra time is not permitted. In the case of an examination that is time-limited, students who believe that they have special circumstances which justify additional time may apply in writing to the Dean of their School for special consideration no later than the beginning of **Week 11** of the semester.
