### ***How to use this document***

The information that appears on the following pages lists the units that are offered in Winter Semester 2019.

The *mode*, *credit points* and *level* are indicated for each unit, as well as the *funding cluster* to which each unit belongs. Please note that funding clusters are relevant only to units that are available to students who are enrolled in initial teacher education courses in Commonwealth supported places.

To calculate the tuition fees or student contribution amount for a particular unit, please refer to the *Unit Costs* information sheet on the CHC website, according to the following guidelines:

- If you are domestic student who is an *Australian citizen*, *Australian permanent resident*, *permanent humanitarian visa holder* or *New Zealand citizen* in a **fee-paying place**, locate the relevant information and table of tuition fees to determine the fees for the unit according to its level (undergraduate 100-level to 400-level; postgraduate 400-level to 600-level) and credit point weighting.
- If you are an *overseas* student in a **fee-paying place**, locate the relevant information and table of tuition fees to determine the fees for the unit according to its level (undergraduate 100-level to 400-level; postgraduate 400-level to 600-level) and credit point weighting.
- If you are a domestic student who is an *Australian citizen*, *Australian permanent resident*, *permanent humanitarian visa holder* or *New Zealand citizen* in a **Commonwealth supported place**, locate the relevant information and table of student contribution amounts to determine the amount for the unit according to its funding cluster and EFTSL value.

The means by which tuition fees and student contribution amounts can be paid are indicated in the relevant sections of the *Unit Costs* information sheet on the CHC website.

### ***Explanatory notes***

The notes below appear in the following pages as column headings or in relation to particular units:

- <sup>1</sup> Level: UG - Undergraduate; PG - Postgraduate;
- <sup>2</sup> Funding Cluster: Information regarding funding clusters applies only to students who are undertaking their course of study in a Commonwealth supported place in an initial teacher education course. Absence of the funding cluster indicates that the unit is not available to students in initial teacher education courses.
- <sup>3</sup> Approval required: The unit is available to those students who require it for course completion purposes only. Enrolment in the unit requires approval by the Course Coordinator.
